AG Forty-Seven embodies the unique spirit and passion of Argentina with its silver thread of tradition and modern-day innovation. Grounded in its heritage and enriched by its people, AG Forty-Seven is the quintessential expression of today's Argentina.

Mendoza sits high in the foothills of El Plata Mountain, named by the Spanish for silver. In line with Argento's philosophy, we hand pick vineyards from the best regions around Mendoza, each with its own personality, allowing us to create fresh, intense wines of fruit purity and finesse.

Tasting Note	This Malbec-Shiraz is a perfect blend of these two varieties. The Malbec gives blackberry and toasty oak characters on the nose, while the Shiraz provides an explosion of black fruit and pepper. Together they form a wine with medium body, ripe fruit flavours, and soft, sweets tannins.
